Project: Intercultural Resources in Kosovo (INTERK)

Dear audience,

We are looking for young people who want to learn how to gain more income in Kosovo. Through training in job application processes (CV and motivation letter writing), entrepreneurship and various activities, you get the chance to learn how to be more successful in the future. Practical examples are there as well: We built the chance for engaging in own community projects for you guys. We know you are awesome!

Caritas is looking for 60 (sixty) young people 18-25 years old from the following municipalities:

Fushë Kosovë/Kosovo Polje, Graçanicë/Gračanica, Kamenicë/Kamenica, Obiliq/Obilić, Prizren and Shtërpce/Štrpce

Successful participants will be rewarded with certificates at the end of the project activities.

Description of the Project:

The INTERK (Intercultural Resources in Kosovo) project is about the income of young people of all ethnic groups living in Kosovo. Through training courses in entrepreneurship, job application processes and creative proposal writing, the income generating competencies of 60 young people are fostered. This is done through workshops, youth camps and 18 small-scale projects.

Young people (participants/trainees) are individuals aged between 18-25, not employed or working in part-time jobs, and speaking English language on a basic level. Under the INTERK project, CaCH is implementing project activities in following municipalities: Fushë Kosovë/Kosovo Polje, Graçanicë/Gračanica, Kamenicë/Kamenica, Obiliq/Obilić, Prizren and Shtërpce/Štrpce. Thus, 60 young people are expected to be from cities/villages under those municipalities.

These young people are attending a workshop (October, 2021), a winter camp (November/December 2021) and a summer camp (June/July 2022). A workshop will last one day, whereas both camps will be organized during weekends and will last 3 days each.

Throughout workshops and camps the participants will be informed and brought to attention following:

- individual capacity building which will be provided to the participants during the activities (e.g. writing good CV and motivation letter, and training in entrepreneurship);
- boosting their abilities to work on developing small scale projects;
- with gained capacities and knowledge participants employment opportunities will be increased;
- the camps will also serve as a platform for cooperation even after finalization of this project through the benefit from small grants
- the developed activities will include fun activities and games

The expenses will be covered, the young people just need to bring motivation and enthusiasm!

Selection criteria of young people:

- 18-25 years old
- Living in one of the six project municipalities: Fushë Kosovë/Kosovo Polje, Graçanicë/Gračanica, Kamenicë/Kamenica, Obiliq/Obilić, Prizren and Shtërpce/Štrpce
- High school students, Bachelor studies students, particularly graduates
- Non-employed or working part-time
- Speaking English language at least on an elementary level

Young people from rural areas are highly encouraged to apply.

The activities are as follows:
